

Notes for starting the Cutting Master 3 downloaded from Website with Mac OS X 10.9.5 (Mavericks) or later

When the Mac OS X 10.9.5 (Mavericks) or later version is used, the warning message of the "can't be opened because the identity of the developer cannot be confirmed." might be appeared after the software that is downloaded from Website is started. In this condition, the software is not able to start. It is because the function of the "Gatekeeper" that has been added for enhancing security from the Mac OS X 10.9.5 has restricted the start-up of the software.

When this warning message appears, the limitation is able to avoid by the following procedure.

Note: Depending on the configuration of the software, the warning message might appears multiple times. In this case, the following steps need to be repeated until the warning message is disappeared.

1. Select the "System Preferences" from the system menu that appears by clicking the Apple icon at the upper left of the screen. Or select it from the Dock that is the toolbar at the bottom of the screen.

2. Select the "Security & Privacy" on the "System Preferences" screen.



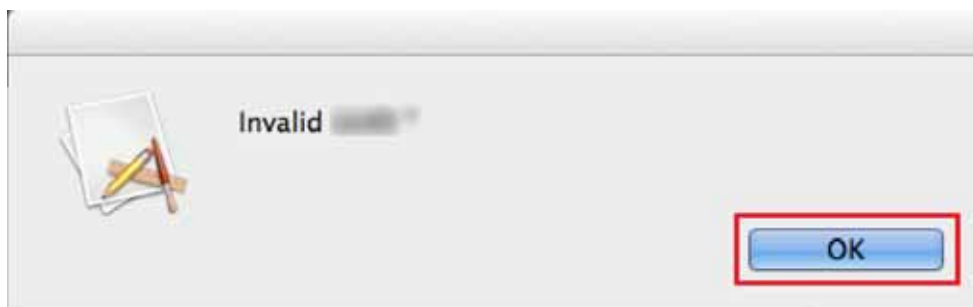
3. Click the button of "Open Anyway" on the "Security & Privacy" screen.



4. Click the button of "Open" after the following message appears.



5. Depending on the software, the following message appears. Click the button of "OK" when that appears.



The software that is downloaded from Website will be able to be used in step above.
